Abstract

Ordin H. Toliver Collection contains a small selection of photographs from Mr. Toliver's US Army enlistment, as a student of the Detroit Music Conservatory (Class of 1927), and his work as a composer and educator. His work as a composer is illustrated in the three arrangements of Negro Spirituals, and his work as an educator is apparent in the class photographs from Toliver Studios located just outside of Detroit in Hamtramck, Michigan.
